**5) Be Willing to Let Go of People** We all have those people, family, friends we love but don't help us to get to the place of our desire.

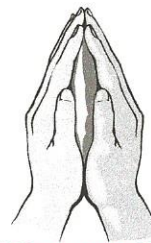
